WHAT DOES EASTER MEAN FOR US?

The following message from the Uniting Church SA Moderator, Rev Sue Ellis appeared in the Advertiser at Easter. "Our news feed is a daily reminder of destruction. Just like so many others across so many nations. Jesus also witnessed destruction and oppression in his lifetime. Death and trauma were daily realities; survival was something many struggled with.



But Jesus came into the world with a message of hope — for the world then and now. His message is one of love so powerful that it can defeat darkness.

At Easter time, we remember with great joy that the very love demonstrated by Jesus proved to be more powerful than death. Oppressed, persecuted and subjected to the horror of crucifixion, Jesus knew darkness, but was raised from death and given a new life by God. This is a story that provides hope to the many who believe in him, even in the midst of dark and difficult times.

After Jesus rose from the dead, the world entered a new season. Jesus' followers were still persecuted — many met violent deaths and others suffered. Yet they did not stop believing and hoping. This new life, this new season, filled them with hope.

It is because of this story that I have hope today — hope for a new life and season for all those facing destruction and darkness".
